

DOT HAZARDOUS MATERIALS FOR DRIVERS

Course Duration: 4 hours | Retrain Frequency: 3 years



COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is designed to provide participants with general information for transporting hazardous materials. Course participants have the opportunity to use excerpts of applicable regulations and gain familiarity with those regulations. The emphasis of this course is transport of hazardous materials in quantities not requiring a Commercial Motor Vehicle (CMV) or Commercial Driver's License (CDL). This training meets the requirements found in 49 CFR 177.816. Materials will be provided to facilitate completing the course.

Successful participants receive a certification stating that the training meets the requirements of 49 CFR 172, Subpart H.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Any person who in the course of employment, transports hazardous materials in quantities not requiring a CMV or CDL.
