



RCRA Container Waste Management

Course Description

This course is designed for personnel performing waste management duties in Satellite Accumulations Areas, 90-Day Accumulation Areas and Permitted Treatment Storage and/or Disposal (TSD) Facilities. Participants will learn:

- Marking requirements for containers
- Importance of segregation of incompatible wastes
- Management and inspection of containers
- Pollution Prevention techniques and requirements
- Record keeping requirements
- Requirements for Contingency Plans
- Inspection requirements
- Response to spills
- Interaction with regulatory agencies

Materials will be provided to facilitate completing the course.

Successful participants receive a certification stating that they completed the course.

Who Should Attend?

Personnel responsible for the management of hazardous waste in Satellite Accumulations Areas, 90-Day Accumulation Areas and Permitted Treatment Storage and/or Disposal Facilities.

Course Duration: 8 hours with an optional 4-hour inspection practical

Retrain Frequency: 1 year

Course Topics:

- Accumulation Requirements including:
 - Marking containers
 - Management and Inspection of containers and safety systems
 - Contingency Plans
 - Record keeping requirements
 - Response to Spills
- Users Responsibilities including:
 - Pollution Prevention
 - Properly managing unknown or unmarked containers
 - Regulatory Agency interaction
 - Notification requirements
- Examination 80% or Better
