COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is directed solely towards the transportation requirements for the shipping of radioactive materials by the International Air Transport Association (IATA) Dangerous Goods Regulations (DGR). The presentation assumes knowledge of domestic regulations for radioactive materials and concentrates on the differences. AAHP has awarded eight (8) CEUs for this class. Materials will be provided to facilitate completing the course.

Successful participants receive a certification stating that the training meets the requirements of 49 CFR 172, Subpart H and IATA, Section 1.5.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Employees required to certify that shipments of radioactive materials are in compliance with DOT's 49CFR and the IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations for domestic air and international transport.
